# **VALUE INFORMATION**

Petition forms are available from the County Property Appraiser's office. Your petition must be filed with the Clerk of Value Adjustment Board on or before 5:00 PM September 15, 2025 at 301 N Olive Ave, West Palm Beach, FL 33401.
